San Jose State record: 2-2. The Spartans lost at Presbyterian (47-46) on November 24.

Santa Clara record: 2-4. The Broncos ended a four-game losing streak by winning at Montana (71-68) on November 30.

San Diego record: 3-3 before the December 1 game at Cal State Bakersfield. The Toreros also face San Diego State on December 6 before hosting the Spartans. Most recently, San Diego defeated San Diego Christian (82-48) on November 29.

San Jose State head coach George Nessman: In his fourth season as head coach. Has a major college coaching record of 26-71, all with the Spartans. As a head coach, Nessman is 1-3 against Santa Clara and 1-1 against San Diego.

Santa Clara head coach Kerry Keating: In his second season as head coach. Has a major college record of 17-20, all with the Broncos. He is 1-1 as a head coach against San Jose State.

San Diego head coach Bill Grier: In his second season as head coach. Has a major college record of 25-17, all with the Toreros. He is 1-0 as a head coach against San Jose State.

San Jose State-Santa Clara series: Santa Clara leads the series, 70-28. The teams split a pair of contests last season with the visiting team winning each game. San Jose State won the most recent game (62-59) at the Leavey Center on January 7, 2008. Santa Clara was victorious at Walt McPherson Court (73-63) on December 8, 2007.

San Jose State-San Diego series: San Diego leads the series, 7-5. The Toreros won last year's game (60-40) on December 5, 2007 at the Jenny Craig Arena.

Seeking a 2-0 home start: San Jose State plays its second home game of the season when the Spartans host Santa Clara. The Spartans won their home opener over California Maritime on November 19. The last time a San Jose State team won its first two home games in a season was in 2002-03 when the Spartans topped Menlo College and Cal State Monterey Bay.

Looking for two in a row over Santa Clara: San Jose State has not beaten Santa Clara in back-to-back games since posting victories over the Broncos on December 22, 1984 (74-67) at the San Jose Civic Auditorium and December 19, 1985 (58-55) at Toso Pavilion. The Spartans' 62-59 victory on January 7, 2008 is the most recent meeting between these teams.

First two of four West Coast Conference opponents: The Santa Clara and San Diego games mark the first two of four West Coast Conference opponents on the San Jose State schedule. Later in December, the Spartans have back-to-back games against USF on December 22 and Saint Mary's in the Shamrock Office Solutions Classic in Moraga, Calif., on December 27. The last time San Jose State played four West Coast Conference teams in a season was 1998-99.

Topping the WAC in scoring defense: After four games, San Jose State tops the Western Athletic Conference in scoring defense allowing 52.2 points a game. Last season after four games, the Spartans yielded 70.2 points a game and had a 3-1 win-loss record. The last time a San Jose State team gave up fewer than 200 points in its first four games was in the 1999-2000 season when Spartan opponents averaged 42.5 points a game.

Topping the WAC in field goal defense: San Jose State's first four opponents have combined to shoot 32.5 percent from the field – the best figure in the WAC for games played through November 30. Nebraska, who defeated the Spartans on November 16, has the best shooting percentage against San Jose State this season with a 35.9 percent mark.

Collecting rebounds: San Jose State has outrebounded each of its last two opponents. The Spartans enter the Santa Clara game with a +2.8 rebounding margin, third best in the Western Athletic Conference for games played through November 30.

Three different lineups: San Jose State started a different starting lineup in each of the first three games. With the return of forward **C.J. Webster**, who missed two games after stepping on the foot of a South Dakota player in the season opener, the Spartans started different lineups at Nebraska and against California Maritime. Forward **Tim Pierce**, center **Chris Oakes** and guards **Justin Graham** and **DaShawn Wright** have started in each of the first four games.

42-point win: San Jose State's 79-37 triumph over Cal Maritime is the largest margin of victory by the Spartans since an 87-41 decision over UC Santa Cruz on November 25, 2003.

Best shooting game of the season: The Cal Maritime win marked the first time in 2008-09 that San Jose State made at least 50 percent of its field goal tries. The Spartans shot 52.5 percent in the victory.

Five double-digit scorers return: The 2007-08 season marked the second time in school history that five Spartans finished a season averaging in double-figure scoring. The 1974-75 team is the first known San Jose State squad to have five players average in double-figure scoring, but only one of those players returned for the following season. For 2008-09, all five players (**Tim Pierce**, **C.J. Webster**, **Chris Oakes**, **Justin Graham** and **DaShawn Wright**) are back for the Spartans.

Successful close calls in 2007-08: San Jose State led the Western Athletic Conference in victories in games decided by four or fewer points with nine victories in 13 contests. One of those wins was the 68-64 triumph over Presbyterian.

Player Updates:

#1 Tim Pierce - team's leading scorer with a double-figure scoring effort in each of the first four games...14 points in the Cal Maritime win (11/19) and at Presbyterian (11/24)...opened the season matching his career high 23 points in the South Dakota State win (11/14) and his first career double-double with 11 points and 10 rebounds at Nebraska (11/16) ...46 starts and 35 double-figure scoring games at San Jose State...fourth on the San Jose State career list for 3-point baskets made (115)...second for career attempts (350)...five games of 20 or more points...averaging 19.3 points a game against Santa Clara including 23 at the Leavey Center in 2006.

#2 Adrian Oliver - second season with the team...University of Washington transfer who expects to be eligible following the 2008 fall semester...projected to be a significant contributor in a backcourt role.

#4 DaShawn Wright - Second in the WAC in steals with a 2.25 average in games played through November 30...has at least one steal in each of the first four games...first double-figure scoring game of the season with 10 points against Cal Maritime (11/19)...28 career starts...double-figure scorer 19 times...first double-double at Nevada (2/7) with 12 points and a career-high 10 rebounds...career-high 20 points at Hawai'i (1/14)...led the 2007-08 team with 46 steals - the second best single-season figure at San Jose State...averaged 11.0 points and 4.0 rebounds in two games against Santa Clara last season.

#5 Justin Graham - Came up with a single-game best 8 rebounds at Presbyterian (11/24)...dished out a career high 7 assists in the Cal Maritime win (11/19)...11 points at South Dakota State (11/14) and a team-high 4 assists at Nebraska (11/16)...redshirt in 2006-07...had one of the best seasons for a San Jose State freshman...just the third freshman to lead the Spartans in assists in a season with 76...set a single-game freshman scoring record with 29 points against Hawai'i (1/5/08)...double-figure scorer in 15 games and scored 20 or more points twice as a Spartan...aver-

aged 11.5 points and 4.0 assists in two games against Santa Clara last season.

#15 Clint Amberry - played in each of the first four games...season high 2 rebounds against Cal Maritime (11/19)...made a pair of free throws at South Dakota State (11/14) for his first major college points...redshirt in 2007-08.

#20 Lance Olivier - played in each of the first four games as a reserve guard...career high 2 assists against Cal Maritime (11/19)...one steal in the Nebraska game (11/16)...appeared in one game last season...acknowledged as the shortest player in Division I basketball standing 5-foot-2.

#21 DeVonte Thomas - seeks to bounce back after just eight minutes of action at Presbyterian in which he collected one rebound and was scoreless...led the team in rebounding in the Cal Maritime win with 8 rebounds...third on the team in rebounding with a 5.0 average...6 points and 6 rebounds coming off the bench in the South Dakota State win (11/14)...started at Nebraska and was credited with 5 rebounds...12 career starts...nine career double-figure scoring games and a double-double in the 2006-07 season.

#22 C.J. Webster - returned to the starting lineup against Presbyterian (11/24) and notched a season-high 11 points before fouling out...7 points and 3 rebounds at South Dakota State (11/14)...missed the Nebraska game due to injury...2007-08 Western Athletic Conference All-Newcomer team selection...34 career starts for the Spartans...22 double-figure scoring games and six double-doubles in 2007-08...best assist-to-turnover ratio (1.36:1) among WAC post players last season...only San Jose State starter with more assists than turnovers...averaged 12.0 points and 7.5 assists in two games against Santa Clara last season...had a double-double of 12 points and 11 rebounds in the win at Santa Clara (1/7/08) which helped earn him WAC Player of the Week honors.

#23 Robert Owens - seeks to regain his offense after making just two free throws at Presbyterian (11/24)...team's most accurate three-point shooter at 50 percent (7-of-14)...game-high 19 points in the Cal Maritime win (11/19)...made five 3-point baskets in the win...8 points at Nebraska (11/16) in a reserve role after going scoreless at South Dakota State...community college transfer from City College of San Francisco.

#30 Chris Oakes - top rebounder in the Western Athletic Conference for games played through November 30 with his 9.8 average...picked up his third double-digit rebounding game of the season with 10 at Presbyterian (11/24)...scored in double-figures in each of the first three games before tallving 6 points at Presbyterian...opened the

season with a pair of double-doubles...only WAC player to do so in his first two games...12 points, 13 rebounds at South Dakota State (11/14) and 12 points and 10 rebounds at Nebraska (11/16)...second in the WAC with 10 blocked shots...career-high 4 blocks at Nebraska...29 starts at San Jose State...22 career double-figure scoring games with 18 of them at San Jose State last season...10 career double-digit rebounding games including nine at San Jose State...4 points and 5 rebounds in the win at Santa Clara (1/7/08).

#32 John Williams - first season with the team...5 points in his San Jose State debut against Cal Maritime (11/19)...joined the squad as a walk-on from Gavilan College...played three games and started twice for Central Connecticut State in the 2006 season.

#33 Mac Peterson - 5 points and his first assist of the season against Cal Maritime (11/19)...8 points in a reserve role at Nebraska (11/16)...had logged 74 minutes in two games - most by a San Jose State bench player...played in 27 games last season and was one of three WAC players last season who logged at least 400 minutes without a starting assignment.

#40 Oliver Caballero - third season with the team...center who is recovering from an injury and is not expected to see action at the beginning of the season...appeared in 25 games as a redshirt freshman and started five times.

#50 Garrett Ton - scored 2 points and grabbed 2 rebounds against Cal Maritime (11/19)...played at Nebraska (11/16) and did not score...2007-08 redshirt.

#52 Jerelle Wilson - reserve guard who scored 3 points against Cal Maritime (11/19)...played one minute at Nebraska (11/16) and did not score.
