## SAN JOSE STATE UNIVERSITY MEN'S BASKETBALL FACT SHEET (GAMES #7 & #8)

**Upcoming games:** Northern Colorado, Saturday, December 20, 2008,  
San Jose Civic Auditorium, San Jose, Calif., 3:00 p.m. (PST)

University of San Francisco, Monday, December 22, 2008,  
Walt McPherson Court, San Jose, Calif., 7:00 p.m. (PST)

**San Jose State record:** 3-3. The Spartans defeated the University of San Diego (56-52) on December 8 to end a two-game losing streak.

**Northern Colorado record:** 2-5 before the December 16 game against the University of Portland. The Bears also face Fresno State on December 18 prior to taking on San Jose State. Northern Colorado has a three-game losing streak after losing to Creighton (85-66) on December 13 in Las Vegas.

**USF record:** 7-4. The Dons have won two of their last three games including a December 13 win at Boise State (79-76).

**San Jose State head coach George Nessman:** In his fourth season as head coach. Has a major college coaching record of 27-72, all with the Spartans. As a head coach, Nessman is 0-0 against Northern Colorado and 0-0 against USF.

**Northern Colorado head coach Tad Boyle:** In his third season as head coach. Has a major college record of 19-45, all with the Bears. He is 0-0 as a head coach against San Jose State.

**USF head coach Rex Walters:** In his first season with the Dons. Has a record of 7-4. Overall, Walters, a product of San Jose's Piedmont Hills High School, has a major college coaching record of 38-37. He is 0-0 as a head coach against San Jose State.

**San Jose State-Northern Colorado series:** The two teams are meeting for the first time.

**San Jose State-USF series:** The Dons lead the series, 40-18. The two teams are meeting for the first time since November 25, 1997 when USF posted a 84-52 win at Memorial Gym on the USF campus. The Spartans' last win in the series was a 65-53 decision on December 11, 1996 at The Event Center. San Jose State has won four of the last five meetings between these teams dating back to the 1985-86 season. The Spartans and the Dons faced each other at least twice a season from the 1950 through 1969 seasons.

**Returning to the San Jose Civic Auditorium:** For the first time since January 22, 1995 against UC Irvine, San Jose State will play a men's basketball game in the San Jose Civic Auditorium. The Anteaters topped the Spartans, 85-74. From the 1979 through 1989 and the 1971 through 1977 seasons, the Civic Auditorium was the primary home for the Spartans. Prior to 1970, San Jose State played home games at the Civic Auditorium and the on-campus Spartan Gym.

**Back to .500:** San Jose State's 56-52 win at the University of San Diego on December 8 drew the Spartans back to the .500 mark for the third time this season and ended a two-game losing streak.

**Topping a 2008 NCAA Tournament team:** The San Diego win marked the first time in seven seasons that San Jose State picked up a win against a team that appeared in the previous season's NCAA Tournament. San Diego advanced to the second round of the 2008 NCAA Tournament. Prior to beating San Diego, the 2001 win at Iowa State was the last time the Spartans defeated a team competed in the previous season's NCAA Tournament.

**Early road success:** San Jose State improved to 2-2 on the road with its win at the University of San Diego. This season's Spartans are one of four Western Athletic Conference teams with two road victories in the first month of non-conference play. Last season, San Jose State was 4-3 on the road in non-conference action.

**First close win for the Spartans:** San Jose State's last three games were decided by four points or less on the scoreboard. The Spartans are 1-2 in these games with the San Diego win following a three-point loss to Santa Clara and a one-point decision at Presbyterian. Last season, San Jose State was the most successful team in the Western Athletic Conference in games decided by four or fewer points. The Spartans were 9-4.

**Third of four West Coast Conference opponents:** The USF game is the third of four West Coast Conference opponents on the San Jose State schedule. Later in December,

the Spartans play at Saint Mary's in the Shamrock Office Solutions Classic in Moraga, Calif., on December 27. The last time San Jose State played four West Coast Conference teams in a season was 1998-99.

**Topping the WAC in scoring defense:** After six games, San Jose State tops the Western Athletic Conference in scoring defense allowing 53.6 points a game. Last season after six games, the Spartans yielded 69.0 points a game. The last time a San Jose State team gave up fewer than 55 points a game in its first six games was in the 1999-2000 season when Spartan opponents averaged 47.3 points a game.

**Topping the WAC in field goal defense:** San Jose State's opponents have combined to shoot 34.8 percent from the field – the best figure in the WAC for games played through December 14. Santa Clara is the first team to shoot better than 40 percent from the field against San Jose State with a 43.4 percentage.

**Free throw line frequency:** San Jose State is averaging 18.2 free throw attempts per game compared to the opponent's 12.5.

**Best free throw shooting at San Diego:** San Jose State had its best free throw shooting game of the season in its 56-52 win at San Diego. The Spartans made 11-of-15 tries including 6-of-6 in the second half for the win. For the season, San Jose State is shooting 60.6 from the free throw line. **Mac Peterson** (90.0 percent) is the only Spartan with at least 75 minutes played who is shooting at least 70 percent from the free throw line.

**Three different lineups:** San Jose State started a different starting lineup in each of the first three games. With the return of forward **C.J. Webster**, who missed two games after stepping on the foot of a South Dakota player in the season opener, the Spartans started different lineups at Nebraska and against California Maritime. Forward **Tim Pierce**, center **Chris Oakes** and guards **Justin Graham** and **DaShawn Wright** have started in each of the first six games.

**42-point win:** San Jose State's 79-37 triumph over Cal Maritime is the largest margin of victory by the Spartans since an 87-41 decision over UC Santa Cruz on November 25, 2003.

**Best shooting game of the season:** The Cal Maritime win marked the first time in 2008-09 that San Jose State made at least 50 percent of its field goal tries. The Spartans shot 52.5 percent in the victory.

**Five double-digit scorers return:** The 2007-08 season marked the second time in school history that five Spartans finished a season averaging in double-figure scoring. The 1974-75 team is the first known San Jose State squad to have five players average in double-figure scoring, but only one of those players returned for the following season. For 2008-09, all five players (**Tim Pierce**, **C.J. Webster**, **Chris Oakes**, **Justin Graham** and **DaShawn Wright**) are back for the Spartans.

#### Player Updates:

**#1 Tim Pierce** - team's leading scorer with a double-figure scoring effort in each of the first six games...matched his career scoring high for the second time this season with 23 at San Diego (12/8)...scored 21 of his 23 in the San Diego win after halftime and was 5-of-5 from three point range in the final 20 minutes...fifth in the WAC in scoring (17.2 ppg.)...led the Spartans with 18 points against Santa Clara (12/3)...14 points in the Cal Maritime win (11/19) and at Presbyterian (11/24)...opened the season with 23 points in the South Dakota State win (11/14) and his first career double-double with 11 points and 10 rebounds at Nebraska (11/16) ...had a six-game dou-

ble-figure scoring streak in 2007-08...48 starts and 37 double-figure scoring games at San Jose State...second on the San Jose State career list for 3-point baskets made (122) and career attempts (365)...six games of 20 or more points.

**#2 Adrian Oliver** - Second season with the team...University of Washington transfer who expects to be eligible following the 2008 fall semester...could be in the lineup as soon as December 20...projected to be a significant contributor in a backcourt role.

**#4 DaShawn Wright** - Fourth in the WAC in steals with a 1.83 average in games played through December 14...has at least one steal in each of the first six games...first double-figure scoring game of the season with 10 points against Cal Maritime (11/19)...coming off a season-low 2 points at San Diego (12/8)...30 career starts...double-figure scorer 19 times...first double-double at Nevada (2/7) with 12 points and a career-high 10 rebounds...career-high 20 points at Hawai'i (1/14)...led the 2007-08 team with 46 steals – the second best single-season figure at San Jose State.

**#5 Justin Graham** - Scored the game's final four points, dished out 6 assists and was credited with a single-game best 5 steals in the San Diego win (12/8)...WAC leader in steals with his 2.33 per game average...sixth in the WAC in assists with his 4.0 average...season-high 13 points and 4 steals against Santa Clara (12/3)...two double-figure scoring games this season...came up with a single-game best 8 rebounds at Presbyterian (11/24)...dished out a career high 7 assists in the Cal Maritime win (11/19)...11 points at South Dakota State (11/14) and a team-high 4 assists at Nebraska (11/16)...redshirt in 2006-07...had one of the best seasons for a San Jose State freshman...just the third freshman to lead the Spartans in assists in a season with 76...set a single-game freshman scoring record with 29 points against Hawai'i (1/5/08)...double-figure scorer in 16 games and scored 20 or more points twice as a Spartan.

**#15 Clint Amberry** - played in each of the first six games...season scoring high of 3 points at San Diego (12/8)...season high 2 rebounds against Cal Maritime (11/19)...made a pair of free throws at South Dakota State (11/14) for his first major college points...redshirt in 2007-08.

**#20 Lance Olivier** - played in each of the first six games as a reserve guard...an assist in each of the last two games...career high 2 assists against Cal Maritime (11/19)...one steal in the Nebraska game (11/16)...appeared in one game last season...acknowledged as the shortest player in Division I basketball standing 5-foot-2.

**#21 DeVonte Thomas** - seeks a bounce back after going scoreless at San Diego...has scored points in the team's

odd numbered games this season to date... contributed 4 points and 7 rebounds in a reserve role against Santa Clara...led the team in rebounding in the Cal Maritime win with 8 rebounds...tied for third on the team in rebounding with a 4.5 average...6 points and 6 rebounds coming off the bench in the South Dakota State win (11/14)...started at Nebraska and was credited with 5 rebounds...12 career starts...nine career double-figure scoring games and a double-double in the 2006-07 season...was the only Spartan to score in double figures with 11 points in the 2007 loss to San Diego.

**#22 C.J. Webster** - starter the last three games and four times this season...season high 7 rebounds against Santa Clara (12/3)...returned to the starting lineup against Presbyterian (11/24) and notched a season-high 11 points before fouling out...7 points and 3 rebounds at South Dakota State (11/14)...missed the Nebraska game due to injury...2007-08 Western Athletic Conference All-Newcomer team selection...36 career starts for the Spartans...22 double-figure scoring games and six double-doubles in 2007-08...best assist-to-turnover ratio (1.36:1) among WAC post players last season...only San Jose State starters with more assists (9) than turnovers (5).

**#23 Robert Owens** - quiet offensively the last three games with 3 points against Santa Clara (12/3), two made free throws at Presbyterian (11/24) and a missed 3-point field goal try at San Diego (12/8)...team's most accurate three-point shooter at 43.8 percent (7-of-16)...game-high 19 points in the Cal Maritime win (11/19)...made five 3-point baskets in the win...8 points at Nebraska (11/16) in a reserve role...community college transfer from City College of San Francisco.

**#30 Chris Oakes** - top rebounder and number-one in blocked shots in the Western Athletic Conference for games played through December 14 with his 9.8 average...has grabbed at least six rebounds in each of the first five games...picked up his fourth double-digit rebounding game of the season with a career-high 14 at San Diego (12/8)...picked up his third double-double of the season at San Diego with 16 points...scored in double-figures in each of the first three games...opened the season with a pair of double-doubles...12 points, 13 rebounds at South Dakota State (11/14) and 12 points and 10 rebounds at Nebraska (11/16)...tied for second in the WAC with 12 blocked shots...career-high 5 blocks at San Diego...31 starts at San Jose State...23 career double-figure scoring games with 19 of them at San Jose State last season...11 career double-digit rebounding games including 10 at San Jose State.

**#32 John Williams** - first season with the team...played one minute as a reserve for his second appearance of the season in the San Diego win (12/8)...5 points in his San Jose State debut against Cal Maritime (11/19)...joined the

squad as a walk-on from Gavilan College...played three games and started twice for Central Connecticut State in the 2006 season.

**#33 Mac Peterson** - played in each of the first six games...team's leading free throw shooter at 90.0 percent (9-of-10)...used as a replacement free throw shooter against Santa Clara and made his only attempt...5 points and his first assist of the season against Cal Maritime (11/19)...8 points in a reserve role at Nebraska (11/16)...played in 27 games last season and was one of three WAC players last season who logged at least 400 minutes without a starting assignment.

**#40 Oliver Caballero** - third season with the team...center who is recovering from an injury and is not expected to see action until sometime in conference play...appeared in 25 games as a redshirt freshman and started five times.

**#50 Garrett Ton** - scored 2 points and grabbed 2 rebounds against Cal Maritime (11/19)...played at Nebraska (11/16) and did not score...2007-08 redshirt.

**#52 Jerelle Wilson** - reserve guard who scored 3 points against Cal Maritime (11/19)...played one minute at Nebraska (11/16) and did not score.
