San Jose State record: 5-3. The Spartans have their first three-game winning streak of the season after defeating USF (82-76) on December 22, Northern Colorado (89-78) on December 20 and the University of San Diego (56-52) on December 8.

Saint Mary's record: 10-1. The Gaels have a seven-game winning streak after beating Pacific (74-65) on December 23 in Stockton, Calif.

Morgan State record: 4-6, 1-0 Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference. The Bears won their last two games including at DePaul (79-75) on December 10.

William Jessup record: 6-8, 2-1 Cal Pac. The Warriors' five-game winning streak ended in a loss at Cal State Hayward (102-83) on December 20.

San Jose State head coach George Nessman: In his fourth season as head coach. Has a major college coaching record of 28-72, all with the Spartans. Nessman is 0-1 against Saint Mary's and 0-0 against Morgan State and William Jessup.

Saint Mary's head coach Randy Bennett: In his eighth season with the Gaels. Has a major college coaching record of 137-91, all at Saint Mary's. He is 1-0 as a head coach against San Jose State.

Morgan State head coach Todd Bozeman: In his third season with the Bears. Has a record of 39-35 with the Bears. Overall, he is in seventh season as a head coach and has a record of 92-70. He is 0-0 as a head coach against San Jose State.

William Jessup head coach Aaron Muhic: In his ninth season with the Warriors. Overall, he is in 13th season as a college head coach and has a record of 211-258. He is 0-0 as a head coach against San Jose State.

San Jose State-Saint Mary's series: The Gaels lead the series, 38-37. Saint Mary's has won the last three meetings between these teams including a 78-60 decision at McKeon Pavilion on December 30, 2006. The Gaels have won the last two times these teams played in Moraga. San Jose State's last victory in the series was on November 26, 2000 (82-68) on Saint Mary's homecourt.

San Jose State-Morgan State series: Possibly, the first meeting between these teams.

San Jose State-William Jessup series: Possibly, the first meeting between these teams.

Seeking Four Wins in a Row: San Jose State is chasing its first four-game winning streak since the 2003-04 season when it faces Saint Mary's. Since the 2004 season, the Spartans have had two chances (2005-06 and 2007-08) to extend a winning streak to four games in a row.

Possibly Three Games Above .500: If San Jose State defeats Saint Mary's, the Spartans can be three wins above the .500 mark nine games into a season for the first time since the 2001 season when that team was 6-3.

Voting is in: Saint Mary's is the only opponent on the San Jose State schedule with votes in either the Associated Press or ESPN coaches poll. Currently, the Gaels are 31st in the Associated Press and 32nd in the ESPN coaches polls.

Last of four West Coast Conference opponents: The Saint Mary's game on December 27 is the last of four West Coast Conference opponents on the San Jose State schedule. The Spartans are 2-1 against West Coast Conference schools this season. The last time San Jose State played four West Coast Conference teams in a season was 1998-99.

Back-to-back 80-point games: The wins over USF (82-76) and Northern Colorado (89-78) marked the first time since the 2002 season that San Jose State scored 80 or more points in back-to-back contests. The last time a Spartan team scored 80 or more points in three consecutive games was in the 1996 season when San Jose State went on a late-season surge en route to its most recent NCAA Tournament appearance.

Pair of 20's: Covering 41 games from February 24, 2006 through December 8, 2008, the Spartans did not have two players score 20 or more points in the same game. In the Northern Colorado (12/20) and USF (12/22) victories, two San Jose State players scored 20 or more points. **Adrian Oliver** (27) and **Tim Pierce** (26) combined to do it in the Northern Colorado victory on December 20. Oliver (31) and **C.J. Webster** (20) were the high-scoring tandem against USF on December 22.

Shooting eyes currently in focus: During San Jose State's three-game winning streak, the Spartans are shooting 53.9 percent from the field including 45.0 percent from three-point range. In the team's first five games when San Jose State compiled a 2-3 record, the Spartans made just 40.7 percent of their field goal attempts and 26.9 percent of their three-point tries.

Distributing the ball: In the last three games, San Jose State was credited with 54 assists or 18.0 per game. In the first five contests, the Spartans average 10.6 assists a game. The percentage of assists-to-baskets in the last three games is 65.1 percent compared to just 47.3 percent in the team's first five contests.

A best in the WAC: San Jose State's 89-78 win over Northern Colorado on December 20, arguably, was the best offensive effort by a Western Athletic Conference team this season. The Spartans shot 66.7 percent from the field and 64.3 percent from three-point range - both conference bests this season. Also, San Jose State converted 92.3 percent of its free throw tries. For the game, San Jose State made 71.8 percent of its total shot attempts (34-of-51 field goals, 12-of-13 free throws).

Best one-game field goal shooting in years: San Jose State's 66.7 percent field goal shooting in the Northern Colorado win marked the first time since a January 30, 1999 victory over San Diego State that the Spartans shot at least 60 percent from the field in a game (62.3 percent) and was the best by the team since a November 26, 1993 triumph over Gonzaga (65.4 percent) in the Stanford Invitational.

Most single-game assists in three years: San Jose State was credited with 23 assists in the Northern Colorado win. The last time the Spartans had as many assists in a game was in a 90-85 win over Rice on January 29, 2005 when the team was credited with 24 assists.

Oliver's debut: **Adrian Oliver** had one of the most spectacular statistical debuts by a San Jose State mid-year transfer in the Northern Colorado game (12/20). The transfer from the University of Washington poured in a game-high 27 points, blocked 3 shots, handed out 2 assists and was credited with a steal in the victory.

Other prominent transfers to San Jose State who became eligible during the season and their Spartan debuts include current center Chris Oakes, guard Brandon Hawkins (2002-03), forward Cory Powell (2000-01) and forward Olivier Saint-Jean (1996-97), who went on to play eight seasons in the NBA as Tariq Abdul-Wahad:

Oakes was the team's leading rebounder last season. Hawkins, Powell and Saint-Jean each led the Spartans in scoring average in back-to-back seasons.

Yielding less than 60: After eight games, San Jose State is one of two teams in the Western Athletic Conference allowing less than 60 points a game. The Spartans enter the Saint Mary's game allowing 59.2 per contest.

Topping the WAC in field goal defense: San Jose State's opponents have combined to shoot 38.9 percent from the field – the best figure in the WAC for games played through December 22.

Pierce a record-setter: Forward **Tim Pierce** became the new San Jose State career record holder for 3-points baskets made. He broke the old record of 123 set by **Michael Quinney** against Northern Colorado (12/20). In the USF win, Pierce also passed the San Jose State record for career 3-point basket attempts of 375 set by **Tito Addison** during the 1995 through 1997 seasons.

Graham's 13 assists: Guard **Justin Graham** became the first Spartan in three years to be credited with at least 10 assists in a game with his personal best of 13 in the Northern Colorado win (12/20). His 13 assists matches the second best single-game total by a San Jose State player and is the top mark by a Western Athletic Conference player in games played through December 22.

Topping a 2008 NCAA Tournament team: The San Diego win marked the first time in seven seasons that San Jose State picked up a win against a team that appeared in the previous season's NCAA Tournament. San Diego advanced to the second round of the 2008 NCAA Tournament. Prior to beating San Diego, the 2001 win at Iowa State was the last time the Spartans defeated a team competed in the previous season's NCAA Tournament.

Early road success: San Jose State improved to 2-2 on the road with its win at the University of San Diego. Last season, San Jose State was 4-3 in non-conference road games.

First close win for the Spartans: San Jose State's 56-52 win over San Diego upped the Spartans' record to 1-2 in games decided by four points or less. Previously, San Jose State lost a one-point decision at Presbyterian (11/24) and a three-point game to Santa Clara (12/3). Last season, the Spartans were the WAC's most successful team in games decided by four or fewer points. The Spartans were 9-4.

Four starting different lineups: The Northern Colorado game marked the fourth different starting lineup for San Jose State this season. **Adrian Oliver** made his debut for the Spartans and was in the starting lineup at a guard position. Forward **Tim Pierce**, center **Chris Oakes** and guard **Justin Graham** have started in every game this

season.

42-point win: San Jose State's 79-37 triumph over Cal Maritime is the largest margin of victory by the Spartans since an 87-41 decision over UC Santa Cruz on November 25, 2003.

Five double-digit scorers return: The 2007-08 season marked the second time in school history that five Spartans finished a season averaging in double-figure scoring. The 1974-75 team is the first known San Jose State squad to have five players average in double-figure scoring, but only one of those players returned for the following season. For 2008-09, all five players (**Tim Pierce, C.J. Webster, Chris Oakes, Justin Graham and DaShawn Wright**) are back for the Spartans.

#1 Tim Pierce - team's top point-producer with a double-figure scoring effort in each of the first eight games...first time as a Spartan he has scored in double-figures in eight consecutive games...21.7 scoring average and 11-of-22 from 3-point territory the last three games prior to Saint Mary's...new career high 26 against Northern Colorado (12/20)...23 at San Diego (12/8), matching his previous career high ...made nine straight 3-point baskets starting with the second half of the San Diego game (five) and the first half of the Northern Colorado contest (four)...scored 21 of his 23 in the San Diego win after halftime...second in the WAC in scoring (18.1 ppg.)...second in the WAC in 3-point field goals made per game (2.50)...opened the season with 23 points in the South Dakota State win (11/14)...first career double-double of 11 points and 10 rebounds at Nebraska (11/16) ...50 starts and 39 double-figure scoring games at San Jose State...seven games of 20 or more points; three of them occurring this season.

#2 Adrian Oliver - 58 points in his first two games at San Jose State are the most points scored by a player in his first two Spartan games...31 points in the USF win (12/22) are the most points by a San Jose State player in a game since the 2005 season...spectacular first game with 27 points against Northern Colorado (12/20) - the highest known point total by a San Jose State player in a debut...led the team in scoring and in blocked shots with three...logged 37 minutes in his first game.

#4 DaShawn Wright - Came off the bench with a career-high 5 assists in the USF (12/22) victory...8 points and 2 assists in the Northern Colorado win (12/20)...sixth in the WAC in steals with a 1.50 average in games played through December 22...had at least one steal in each of the first six games...first double-figure scoring game of the season with 10 points against Cal Maritime (11/19)...30 career starts...double-figure scorer 19 times...first double-double at Nevada (2/7) with 12 points and a career-high

10 rebounds...career-high 20 points at Hawai'i (1/14)...led the 2007-08 team with 46 steals – the second best single-season figure at San Jose State.

#5 Justin Graham - WAC leader in steals with a 2.50 average which includes four in the USF win (12/22)...up to third in the WAC in assists with a 5.4 average - his highest at any time at the major college level...25 assists in the last three games prior to Saint Mary's...scored the game's final four points, dished out 6 assists and was credited with a single-game best 5 steals in the San Diego win (12/8)...season-high 13 points and 4 steals against Santa Clara (12/3)...two double-figure scoring games this season...single-game best 8 rebounds at Presbyterian (11/24)...11 points at South Dakota State (11/14)...redshirt in 2006-07...had one of the best seasons for a San Jose State freshman...just the third freshman to lead the Spartans in assists in a season with 76...set a single-game freshman scoring record with 29 points against Hawai'i (1/5/08)...double-figure scorer in 16 games and scored 20 or more points twice as a Spartan.

#15 Clint Amberry - made a pair of free throws in the USF win (12/22)...posted his season scoring high of 3 points in the University of San Diego win (12/8)...season high 2 rebounds against Cal Maritime (11/19).

#20 Lance Olivier - last played in the San Diego win (12/8)...career high 2 assists against Cal Maritime (11/19)...one steal in the Nebraska game (11/16)...appeared in one game last season...acknowledged as the shortest player in Division I basketball standing 5-foot-2.

#21 DeVonte Thomas - scored 2 points and grabbed 2 rebounds in the Northern Colorado win (12/20)...has scored points only in the team's odd numbered games this season to date...4 points and 7 rebounds in a reserve role against Santa Clara (12/3)...led the team in rebounding in the Cal Maritime win with 8 rebounds...6 points and 6 rebounds coming off the bench in the South Dakota State win (11/14)...started at Nebraska and was credited with 5 rebounds...12 career starts...nine career double-figure scoring games and a double-double in the 2006-07 season.

#22 C.J. Webster - most productive game of the season in the USF win (12/22) with 20 points, 8 rebounds and 2 steals ...returned to the starting lineup against Presbyterian (11/24) and notched 11 points...7 points and 3 rebounds at South Dakota State (11/14)...missed the Nebraska game due to injury...2007-08 Western Athletic Conference All-Newcomer team selection...38 career starts for the Spartans...23 double-figure scoring games and six double-doubles in 2007-08...best assist-to-turnover ratio (1.36:1) among WAC post players last season...one of two San Jose State starters with more assists (12) than turnovers (8).

#23 Robert Owens - made all his shots in the Northern Colorado win (12/20) with a 3-point basket and two free throws for 5 points...one of two Spartans with significant playing time shooting at least 40 percent from three-point range (40.0 percent, 8-of-20)...game-high 19 points with five 3-pointers in the Cal Maritime win (11/19)...8 points at Nebraska (11/16) in a reserve role...community college transfer from City College of San Francisco.

#30 Chris Oakes - tops in blocked shots (2.13) in the Western Athletic Conference for games played through December 22...second in the WAC in rebounding (8.8)...fourth double-digit rebounding game of the season with a career-high 14 at San Diego (12/8)...picked up his third double-double of the season at San Diego with 16 points...scored in double-figures in each of the first three games...opened the season with a pair of double-doubles...12 points, 13 rebounds at South Dakota State (11/14) and 12 points and 10 rebounds at Nebraska (11/16)...career-high 5 blocks at San Diego...33 starts at San Jose State...23 career double-figure scoring games with 19 of them at San Jose State last season...11 career double-digit rebounding games including 10 at San Jose State.

#32 John Williams - first season with the team...played one minute as a reserve for his second appearance of the season in the San Diego win (12/8)...5 points in his San Jose State debut against Cal Maritime (11/19)...joined the squad as a walk-on from Gavilan College...played three games and started twice for Central Connecticut State in the 2006 season.

#33 Mac Peterson - reserve guard against USF (12/22) who was credited with a rebound...shooting 90.0 percent (9-of-10) from the free throw line...last scored against Santa Clara with one free throw...5 points against Cal Maritime (11/19)...8 points in a reserve role at Nebraska (11/16)...played in 27 games last season and was one of three WAC players last season who logged at least 400 minutes without a starting assignment.

#40 Oliver Caballero - third season with the team...center who is recovering from an injury and is not expected to see action until sometime in conference play...appeared in 25 games as a redshirt freshman and started five times.

#50 Garrett Ton - scored 2 points and grabbed 2 rebounds against Cal Maritime (11/19)...played at Nebraska (11/16) and did not score...2007-08 redshirt.

#52 Jerelle Wilson - reserve guard who scored 3 points against Cal Maritime (11/19)...played one minute at Nebraska (11/16) and did not score.
