SAN JOSE STATE UNIVERSITY MEN'S BASKETBALL FACT SHEET (GAME #12)

Upcoming game: New Mexico State, Monday, January 5, 2009,
Walt McPherson Court, San Jose, Calif., 7:00 p.m.

San Jose State record: 6-5, 0-1 WAC. The Spartans have won four of their last six games, but lost their WAC opener to Louisiana Tech (66-61) on January 3.

New Mexico State record: 7-7, 1-0 WAC. The Aggies have split their last four games, but began WAC action winning at Fresno State (79-66) on January 3.

San Jose State head coach George Nessman: In his fourth season as head coach. Has a major college coaching record of 29-74, all with the Spartans. As a head coach, Nessman is 0-6 against New Mexico State.

New Mexico State head coach Marvin Menzies: In his second season with the Aggies. Has a major college coaching record of 28-21, all at New Mexico State. He is 2-0 as a head coach against San Jose State.

San Jose State-New Mexico State series: The Aggies lead the series, 25-10. New Mexico State has won the last seven meetings between these teams including six since the Aggies joined the conference for the 2005-06 season. San Jose State's last win in the series was a 74-60 triumph on January 8, 1996 when both schools were members of the Big West Conference.

Aiming for 1-1 in WAC play: San Jose State can reach the .500 mark in Western Athletic Conference action with a win over New Mexico State on January 5. The Spartans can be 1-1 in conference play for the first time since the 1999-2000 season when San Jose State lost to TCU and then handled SMU.

Seeking to regain the scoring touch: San Jose State had scored 78 or more points in its four games prior to the 66-61 loss to Louisiana Tech on January 3. The 331 combined points against Northern Colorado, USF, Saint Mary's and William Jessup are the most scored by the Spartans in a four-game span since the 2002 season when San Jose State scored 324 points in games against Notre Dame de Namur, Vanguard University, Mount Saint Mary's and Nevada.

Rebounding proficiency: San Jose State has outrebounded each of its last five opponents. In the team's first six games, the Spartans had more rebounds than an opponent twice (California Maritime and Presbyterian). Heading into the New Mexico State game, San Jose State has a +3.9 rebounding margin.

Potential winning record in non-conference action: With a current record of 6-4, San Jose State has a chance to be above the .500 mark in non-conference action for the second season in a row. In 2007-08, the Spartans were 8-6 in games against non-conference opponents. The last time San Jose State had back-to-back winning records in non-conference play was in 2000 (9-6) and 2001 (8-3).

Three double-doubles in William Jessup win: For the first time in at least the last 30 years at San Jose State, three players recorded a double-double for the Spartans in a game. Forwards **Tim Pierce** (21 pts., 15 rebs.) and **C.J. Webster** (15 pts., 10 rebs.) and center **Chris Oakes** (18 pts., 17 rebs.) each had at least 10 points and 10 rebounds in the 82-61 win over William Jessup on December 28.

Among the NCAA Division I men's teams to match this statistical phenomenon recently are UCLA in an 88-78 win over Western Kentucky in the 2008 NCAA Tournament Tempe, Ariz., Regional on March 27 and Syracuse's 85-73 victory over Seton Hall on March 6, 2008.

65 rebounds in William Jessup win: San Jose State's 65 rebounds in the victory over William Jessup on December 28 matches the third most rebounds by a NCAA Division I team in games played this season through December 28. Eastern Michigan's 76 rebounds against Marygrove on November 14 and Maine's 73 against Maine Presque Isle on December 4 are the top two single-game totals this season.

The last time the Spartans had as many as 60 rebounds as a team in a game was on December 24, 1979 in a 78-63 victory over St. Francis (N.Y.) in the All-College Tournament hosted by Oklahoma City when San Jose State was credited with 60 rebounds.

First team better than 50 percent vs. Saint Mary's: San Jose State became the first team this season to make more than 50 percent of its field goal tries in a game against Saint Mary's. The Spartans shot 51.6 percent from the field in an 87-78 loss to the Gaels in the opening round of the Shamrock Office Solutions Classic on December 27, 2008. Dating back to last season, Saint Mary's kept 23 consecutive opponents from making at least 50 percent of its shots in a game. Since then, the Gaels' next two foes did not shoot at least 50 percent from the field, too.

Shooting eyes currently in focus: In San Jose State's last five games, the Spartans are shooting 49.6 percent (173-of-349) from the field. In the team's first five games when San Jose State compiled a 2-3 record, the Spartans made just 40.7 percent of their field goal attempts.

Five starters combine to be above 50 percent: The San Jose State starting five of forwards **Tim Pierce** and **C.J. Webster**, center **Chris Oakes** and guards **Justin Graham** and **Adrian Oliver** have a combined field goal percentage for the season of 50.5 percent (222-440). All but Pierce enter the New Mexico State game shooting at least 50 percent or better from the field.

Back-to-back 80-point games: The wins over USF (82-76) and Northern Colorado (89-78) marked the first time since the 2002 season that San Jose State scored 80 or more points in back-to-back contests.

Distributing the ball: In the last six games, San Jose State was credited with 103 assists or 17.2 per game. In the first five contests, the Spartans averaged 10.6 assists a game.

Graham's assists average: Guard **Justin Graham** heads into the New Mexico State game with a 5.6 assist average and ranks third in the Western Athletic Conference in games played through January 3. His assist average is the highest by a San Jose State player at any point in a season since 1984 when Michael Dixon finished the season averaging 5.5 per game.

Graham's 13 assists: Guard **Justin Graham** became the first Spartan in three years to be credited with at least 10 assists in a game with his personal best of 13 in the Northern Colorado win (12/20). His 13 assists matches the second best single-game total by a San Jose State player and is the top mark by a Western Athletic Conference player in games played through December 22.

Pair of 20's: Covering 41 games from February 24, 2006 though December 8, 2008, the Spartans did not have two players score 20 or more points in the same game. In the Northern Colorado (12/20) and USF (12/22) victories, two San Jose State players scored 20 or more points. **Adrian Oliver** (27) and **Tim Pierce** (26) combined to do it in the Northern Colorado victory on December 20. Oliver (31) and **C.J. Webster** (20) were the high-scoring tandem against USF on December 22.

Oliver's debut: **Adrian Oliver** had one of the most spectacular statistical debuts by a San Jose State mid-year transfer in the Northern Colorado game (12/20). The transfer from the University of Washington poured in a game-high 27 points, blocked 3 shots, handed out 2 assists and was credited with a steal in the victory.

Other prominent transfers to San Jose State who became eligible during the season and their Spartan debuts include current center **Chris Oakes**, guard **Brandon Hawkins** (2002-03), forward **Cory Powell** (2000-01) and forward **Oliver Saint-Jean** (1996-97), who went on to play eight seasons in the NBA as Tariq Abdul-Wahad:

Oakes was the team's leading rebounder last season. Hawkins, Powell and Saint-Jean each led the Spartans in scoring average in back-to-back seasons.

A best in the WAC: San Jose State's 89-78 win over Northern Colorado on December 20, arguably, was the best offensive effort by a Western Athletic Conference team this season. The Spartans shot 66.7 percent from the field and 64.3 percent from three-point range - both conference bests this season. Also, San Jose State converted 92.3 percent of its free throw tries. For the game, San Jose State made 71.8 percent of its total shot attempts (34-of-51 field goals, 12-of-13 free throws).

Best one-game field goal shooting in years: San Jose State's 66.7 percent field goal shooting in the Northern Colorado win marked the first time since a January 30, 1999 victory over San Diego State that the Spartans shot at least 60 percent from the field in a game (62.3 percent) and was the best by the team since a November 26, 1993 triumph over Gonzaga (65.4 percent) in the Stanford Invitational.

Most single-game assists in three years: San Jose State was credited with 23 assists in the Northern Colorado win. The last time the Spartans had as many assists in a game was in a 90-85 win over Rice on January 29, 2005 when the team was credited with 24 assists.

Topping the WAC in field goal defense: San Jose State's opponents have combined to shoot 39.3 percent from the field – the best figure in the WAC for games played through January 3.

Pierce a record-setter: Forward **Tim Pierce** became the new San Jose State career record holder for 3-points baskets made. He broke the old record of 123 set by **Michael Quinney** against Northern Colorado (12/20). In the USF win, Pierce also passed the San Jose State record for career 3-point basket attempts of 375 set by **Tito Addison** during the 1995 through 1997 seasons. Heading into the New Mexico State game, he is 134-of-404 in games played at San Jose State.

Topping a 2008 NCAA Tournament team: The San Diego win marked the first time in seven seasons that San Jose State picked up a win against a team that appeared in the previous season's NCAA Tournament. San Diego advanced to the second round of the 2008 NCAA Tournament. Prior to beating San Diego, the 2001 win at Iowa State was the last time the Spartans defeated a team competed in the previous season's NCAA Tournament.

First close win for the Spartans: San Jose State's 56-52 win over San Diego upped the Spartans' record to 1-2 in games decided by four points or less. Previously, San Jose State lost a one-point decision at Presbyterian (11/24) and a three-point game to Santa Clara (12/3). Last season, the Spartans were the WAC's most successful team in games decided by four or fewer points. The Spartans were 9-4.

Four starting different lineups: The Northern Colorado game marked the fourth different starting lineup for San Jose State this season. **Adrian Oliver** made his debut for the Spartans and was in the starting lineup at a guard position. Forward **Tim Pierce**, center **Chris Oakes** and guard **Justin Graham** have started in every game this season.

42-point win: San Jose State's 79-37 triumph over Cal Maritime is the largest margin of victory by the Spartans since an 87-41 decision over UC Santa Cruz on November 25, 2003.

#1 Tim Pierce - in the midst of his most productive season at the major college level...team's top point-producer with a double-figure scoring effort in each of the first 11 games...first time as a Spartan he has scored in double-figures in 11 consecutive games...17.7 scoring average the last six games and back-to-back double-doubles ...three career double-doubles after 21 points and a career-best 15 rebounds against William Jessup (12/28)... 10 points and 10 rebounds against Saint Mary's (12/27).....new career scoring high 26 against Northern Colorado (12/20)...23 at San Diego (12/8), matching his previous career high ...made nine straight 3-point baskets starting with the second half of the San Diego game (five) and the first half of the

#2 Adrian Oliver - Scoring average leader at 19.6 per game...80 points in his first three games at San Jose State are the most points scored by a player in his first three Spartan games...31 points in the USF win (12/22) are the most points by a San Jose State player in a game since the 2005 season...spectacular first game with 27 points against Northern Colorado (12/20) - the highest known point total by a San Jose State player in a debut...one of four San Jose State starters shooting better than 50 percent from the field at 50.0 percent.

#4 DaShawn Wright - seeks to bounce back in the New Mexico State game after going scoreless against Louisiana Tech (1/3)...second on the team in steals with 14...had at least one steal in each of the first six games... first double-figure scoring game of the season with 10 points against Cal Maritime (11/19)...30 career starts...double-figure scorer 19 times...first double-double at Nevada (2/7) with 12 points and a career-high 10 rebounds...career-high 20 points at Hawai'i (1/14)...led the 2007-08 team with 46 steals - the second best single-season figure at San Jose State.

#5 Justin Graham - WAC leader in steals with a 2.00 average which includes four in the USF win (12/22)...up to third in the WAC in assists with a 5.6 average - his highest at any time at the major college level...44 assists in the last six games prior to New Mexico State...scored the game's final four points, dished out 6 assists and was credited with a single-game best 5 steals in the San Diego win (12/8)...season-high 13 points and 4 steals against Santa Clara (12/3)...two double-figure scoring games this season...single-game best 8 rebounds at Presbyterian (11/24)...11 points at South Dakota State (11/14)...redshirt in 2006-07...had one of the best seasons for a San Jose State freshman...just the third freshman to lead the Spartans in assists in a season with 76...set a single-game freshman scoring record with 29 points against Hawai'i (1/5/08)...double-figure scorer in 16 games and scored 20 or more points twice as a Spartan.

#15 Clint Amberry - scored points in three of the last five games in which he played...played 3 minutes against Louisiana Tech (1/3) and did not score nor collect a rebound...2 points and a season-high 3 rebounds against William Jessup (12/28)...made a pair of free throws in the USF win (12/22)...posted his season scoring high of 3 points in the University of San Diego win (12/8).

#20 Lance Olivier - last played in the San Diego win (12/8)...career high 2 assists against Cal Maritime (11/19)...one steal in the Nebraska game (11/16)...appeared in one game last season...acknowledged as the shortest player in Division I basketball standing 5-foot-2.

#21 DeVonte Thomas - 2 points and 4 rebounds against Louisiana Tech (1/3) playing 22 minutes - the most by a 4 San Jose State substitute in the Louisiana Tech win...2 points and 4 rebounds against Saint Mary's (12/27)...scored 2 points and grabbed 2 rebounds in the Northern Colorado win (12/20)...4 points and 7 rebounds in a reserve role against Santa Clara (12/3)...led the team in rebounding in the Cal Maritime win with 8 rebounds...6 points and 6 rebounds coming off the bench in the South Dakota State win (11/14)...started at Nebraska and was credited with 5 rebounds...12 career starts...nine career double-figure scoring games and a double-double in the 2006-07 season.

#22 C.J. Webster - WAC Player of the Week for the week ending December 28...averaging 16.8 points and 7.2 rebounds the last four games...shooting 62.7 percent (32-of-51) the last five games...five games in double-figure scoring including each of the last four outings before New Mexico State...most productive game of the season in the USF win (12/22) with 20 points, 8 rebounds and 2 steals ...returned to the starting lineup against Presbyterian (11/24) and notched 11 points...missed the Nebraska game due to injury...2007-08 Western Athletic Conference All-Newcomer team selection...41 career starts for the Spartans...26 double-figure scoring games...six double-doubles in 2007-08 and one this season against William Jessup (12/28)...best assist-to-turnover ratio (1.36:1) among WAC post players last season...one of two San Jose State starters with more assists (18) than turnovers (15).

#23 Robert Owens - notched his second double-figure scoring game of the season with 10 points against William Jessup (12/28) to break out of a two-game scoreless drought...made all his shots in the Northern Colorado win (12/20) with a 3-point basket and two free throws for 5 points...game-high 19 points with five 3-pointers in the Cal Maritime win (11/19)...8 points at Nebraska (11/16) in a reserve role.

#30 Chris Oakes - tops the WAC in blocked shots (1.91) and second in rebounding (9.0)...shooting the ball much better the last six games...67.6 percent (23-of-34) from the field to raise his season percentage to 59.5...15-of-19 from the free throw line (78.9 percent) the last five contests before WAC play giving him a 61.5 percent mark...four double-doubles in 2008-09 after a season-best 18 points and a career-high 17 rebounds against William Jessup (12/28)...six double-figure scoring games this season...five double-digit rebounding game of the season...picked up

his third double-double of the season at San Diego with 16 points and then career-high 14 rebounds...scored in double-figures in each of the first three games...opened the season with a pair of double-doubles...12 points, 13 rebounds at South Dakota State (11/14) and 12 points and 10 rebounds at Nebraska (11/16)...career-high 5 blocks at San Diego...35 starts at San Jose State...25 career double-figure scoring games with 21 of them at San Jose State last season...12 career double-digit rebounding games including 11 at San Jose State.

#32 John Williams - first season with the team...last played against William Jessup (12/28) and was credited with an assist and a rebound...5 points in his San Jose State debut against Cal Maritime (11/19)...joined the squad as a walk-on from Gavilan College...played three games and started twice for Central Connecticut State in the 2006 season.

#33 Mac Peterson - backcourt player whose 3 points were the most scored by a San Jose State reserve in the Louisiana Tech game (1/3)...had a single-game best 5 assists against William Jessup (12/28)...scored 5 points against Saint Mary's (12/27)...shooting 90.0 percent (9-of-10) from the free throw line...5 points against Cal Maritime (11/19)...8 points in a reserve role at Nebraska (11/16)...was one of three WAC players last season who logged at least 400 minutes without a starting assignment.

#40 Oliver Caballero - third season with the team...center who suited up for the first time this season against Louisiana Tech (1/3), but did not see any game action...appeared in 25 games as a redshirt freshman and started five times.
